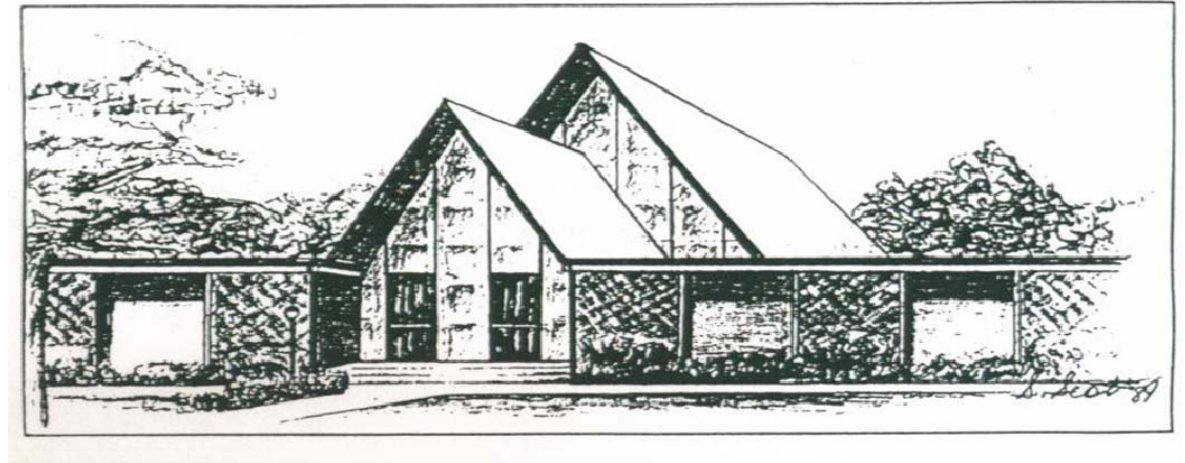

## The Role of the Devil

- He takes money, intended to be used to provide for ourselves and to help others, and causes it to be misused. We call this greed.
- He takes a normal physical attraction between two individuals and causes it to become lust.
- He takes honesty and cause it to become dishonesty.
- He takes truth and cause it to become lies.
- He causes two people trying to help and comfort each other and turns it into an extramarital affair.
- He takes the body of God’s people (the church), intended to uplift and encourage each other, and causes them to turn against each other, bickering and fighting.
