What You'll Find at the Booneville Church of Christ!

- ***Who we are...***You'll find that you probably know many of us already. We're over 300 families that are your neighbors and friends, ball coaches, teachers, nurses, service professionals, factory workers and a whole lot of just plain folk! We are just a "big country church" that happens to be in the middle of town. We promise to do our best to welcome you when you visit with us, but at the same time, we'll not embarrass you in any way!
- ***Where we are...***You'll find our church building and facilities located at 406 North Second street. Our church building is not the church, but we try to use our church building and facilities to glorify God. You'll find our church building with an auditorium and several classrooms along with the annex (used as a large classroom and for fellowship meals, wedding showers, etc.), the student center (for our NEMCC students), the activity center (used for various meetings and activities throughout the year) and our preschool.
- ***What we do in worship...***At the beginning of worship time, someone will welcome everyone and read a few announcements. You are then invited to join in our singing as we sing praises to God. You are welcome to use the song book or look at the words projected on a screen. Since the Bible does not mention allowing instrumental music in the New Testament, we sing only with our voices. There will be a scripture reading and several prayers throughout the service. The preacher will provide us a lesson from God's word, and it will be practical, relevant and Biblically based. There will be an "order of worship" in your pew that will provide not only the order of our worship service, but will have some notes to allow you to follow along with the lesson for the day. At the close of the lesson, we will stand and sing an invitation song to encourage those who need to make some sort of spiritual commitment to do so. If you visit on a Sunday morning, the Lord's Supper will be included at this time. A metal plate containing unleavened bread and then trays containing individual cups of grape juice will be passed down each pew. This is to commemorate the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ where he sacrificed his body (represented by the unleavened bread) and shed his blood (represented by the grape juice). We follow the example of the first century Christians and partake of this every first day of the week. Finally, the weekly financial offering is taken from among the members. As our guest, you are not expected to make a donation. Just pass the plate along. As with the Lord's Supper, we follow the example of the first century Christians and give every first day of the week. We try to do Bible things in Bible ways!
- ***When we worship...***We meet at 9:45 a.m. on Sunday morning and 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday evening for Bible classes. We meet at 10:30 and 6:00 on Sunday evening for worship time. A nursery is available. Personal amplified hearing devices are available. We are available. The only thing missing is you!
- ***Why we have an interest in you...***You are valuable in God's sight and ours, because you have a soul that will live eternally somewhere. Though as a church we financially and physically sponsor several mission efforts all around the globe, we feel an obligation to knock on the doors of our hometown here in Booneville. Taking the gospel to all nations (Matthew 28:19-20) begins with our part of the world!

Ministries/Programs:

Booneville Church of Christ offers an extensive education program offering Bible classes for all ages. There is also a staffed nursery each service and a Bible Hour for children ages three through first grade on Sunday evenings. We offer home Bible studies and correspondence courses free of charge, and provide transportation to all church services. We have a community benevolence program, annual blood drives, vacation Bible school, and a visitation program. Our ministries include helping hands, food ministry, tape/CD ministry, jail ministry, hospital ministry, nursing home ministry, and campus ministry (especially targeting NEMCC students). We are involved in Lads to Leaders/Leaderettes, attend summer Bible camps, support numerous mission works, have a weekly TV program, and have regular fellowship activities for all ages.

Preschool:

Booneville Church of Christ operates a state licensed child care facility at 501 North First Street. It began operation in January 2002 with the purpose of providing spiritual instruction, learning readiness, and social and emotional growth for children 3-5 years of age. The facility is licensed by the state and has a capacity for 35 students. Presently, we have a three old class and a four year old class.

A Place For You

We have a good mix of age groups so we have a place for you at Booneville!

- **Children's Ministry**- numerous things are planned for them throughout the year including outings, an Easter egg hunt, trunk-n-treat. etc. Church camp and vacation Bible school are always a big hit with the kids as well.
- **Youth program**- the youth group has monthly devotionals, special youth days, work camps and mission trips. The youth typically attend Maywood Christian camp and Mid-South Youth Camp, and Horizons at Freed-Hardeman each summer. They also have numerous opportunities to just hang out together.
- **Campus Ministry**- reaches out to the students at Northeast Mississippi Community College as well as other college students and has many activities throughout the school year. They have a weekly fellowship meal following the Wednesday night Bible class, and often "tailgate" before home football games. The Christian student center is open 9 am to 10 pm each day to provide a safe haven off campus for study, surfing the net, or just hanging out.
- **Young Adults**- enjoy numerous fellowship activities including a men's softball team, parents' night's out, football parties, etc. They are also involved in many of our children's and youth activities.
- **Mid Adults**- very active in the various programs of the church and enjoy numerous fellowship activities. Many of them are our Bible class teachers and help tremendously in the various ministries of the church.
- **Golden Circle**- made up of individuals 55 and over and is very active. They enjoy monthly luncheons on the second Tuesday of each month and monthly breakfasts on the third Monday of each month. They host a senior rally each year and attend others in the area. They have many fellowship activities and take several trips each year. They also are heavily involved in the various ministries of the church.
